BUSINESS SUPPORT

To support Victorian businesses impacted by the Circuit Breaker restrictions imposed on 28 May 2021, the Victorian Government has announced a \$250 million package comprising of the following grants:

- Business Cost Assistance Program Round Two
- Licensed Hospital Venue Fund
- Victorian Events Support Package (Details of this package has not yet been provided)

BUSINESS COST ASSISTANCE PACKAGE ROUND TWO

Eligibility

- Businesses located in Victoria that operate in an eligible sector

Closing Date

- Application closes 24 June 2021

Who is Eligible?

To be eligible for the Business Cost Assistance Package Program Round Two, the business must meet each of the following criteria:

- Be located within Victoria.
- Operate in an eligible sector listed in the list of eligible ANZSIC classes for this program.
- Have incurred direct costs because of the restrictions and cannot fully operate remotely.
- Have an annual Victorian payroll of up to \$10 million in 2019-20 on an ungrouped basis.
- Have been registered for Goods and Services Tax (GST) on Thursday 27 May 2021.
- Hold an Australian Business Number (ABN) and have held that ABN at Thursday 27 May 2021.
- Be registered with the responsible Federal or State regulator.

Employing businesses must also:

- Be registered with WorkSafe Victoria.
- Attest that the business is supporting its workers to access any paid leave entitlements, or that if a person can

One-off payment for an eligible business of:

\$2,500

Businesses in eligible industries directly affected by restrictions between 28 May up to and including 3 June 2021

\$5,000

Businesses in eligible industries that continue to remain directly affected by restrictions on and from 4 June 2021

work from home, to work from home during the circuit breaker action, and supporting their casual workers, where possible.

Not-for-profit organisations that are not registered for GST and have an annual turnover between \$75,000 and \$150,000 are also eligible for the grant. The organisation must meet all other eligibility criteria.

Businesses can apply for one grant per ABN.

How to Apply?

Applications for the Business Costs Assistance Program Round Two must be made online at www.businessvic.gov.au.

Eligible Industries

Only businesses operating in the eligible ANZSIC industry code list will be eligible for funding through the Business Costs Assistance Program Round Two. This list applies to both employing and non-employing businesses in Metropolitan Melbourne and Regional Victoria.

LICENSED HOSPITALITY VENUE FUND 2021

Eligibility

- Eligible liquor licensees

Closing Date

- Application closes 24 June 2021

Who is Eligible?

To be eligible for the Licensed Hospitality Venue Fund 2021, the business must meet each of the following criteria:

- Receive an application form link from Business Victoria.
- Operate a licensed bar, restaurant, pub, club, hotel, café or reception centre that is registered to serve food and alcohol located in Victoria on 27 May 2021.
- Hold a general or late night (general), full club, restaurant and cafe, producer's or on-premises or late night (on-premises) liquor licence as of 27 May 2021.
- Provide a Class 2 or 3 Service Sector Certificate of Registration under the Food Act 1984 that is valid in 2021 for serving food on the same premises.
- Be registered for goods and services tax (GST) on 27 May 2021.

One-off payment for an eligible business of:

\$3,500

Businesses located in regional Victoria that holds a liquor licence

\$7,000

Businesses located in Metropolitan Melbourne that holds a liquor licence

- Hold an Australian Business Number (ABN) and have held that ABN at 27 May 2021.
- Be registered with the responsible Commonwealth or Victorian regulator.

Employing businesses must also:

- Attest that the business is supporting its workers to access any paid leave entitlements, or that if a person can work from home, to work from home during the circuit breaker action, and supporting their casual workers, where possible.

How to Apply?

Eligible applicants will receive an email from Business Victoria with a link to the online application form by 20 June 2021.

TEMPORARY COVID DISASTER PAYMENT

Weekly payment of:

\$500

if you work 20 hours or more of work per week

\$375

if you lose less than 20 hours of work per week

The Federal Government has announced the introduction of a new financial support package, the Temporary COVID Disaster Payment. The new support is aimed at assisting workers who are unable to attend work in a state or territory that has been declared a Commonwealth hotspot area and subject to state-imposed lockdown restrictions.

Who is Eligible?

To be eligible for the Temporary COVID Disaster Payment, the individual must be:

- An Australian, a permanent resident or an eligible working visa holder (details for eligible working visa holder yet to be released).
- Have liquid assets of less than \$10,000.
- Have exhausted leave entitlements (excluding annual leave) such as special pandemic sick leave.
- Living in a Commonwealth-defined hotspot with a lockdown period of greater than 7 days.
- Not receiving any other income support payments, business support payments, or the Pandemic Leave Disaster Payment.
